#### **PRESENTATION OF SCHOLARSHIP**

On 9<sup>th</sup> of November, 2018 the foundation started her campaign at Irekari Community Primary School Akure, Ondo state, Nigeria where we presented scholarship award of ₦15, 000 for the best student in primary six to take care of his Common Entrance Examination in person of **ADEMUYIWA OJO**.

On 20<sup>th</sup> of November, the foundation also proceeded to Oyemekun Grammar School Akure, Ondo state, Nigeria to present scholarship award to the best student in SS3 in person of **AKERELE OLUWASEENI** with sum of ₦35, 000 to take care of his WAEC and NECO examinations.

#### **TRAINING PROGRAMME**

The foundation in quest to fulfil one of her mandate conducted 5days in February and March 2019 training programme at Oyemekun Grammar School Akure, Ondo state, Nigeria where about 80 students trained on computer repair and mobile phone repair. The certificate of training were presented to the participants on 24<sup>th</sup> of May, 2019.

The foundation continues with her programme to Fiwasaye Girls Grammar School Akure, Ondo state where over 200 students were training on:

**Catering Services** which includes how to make Puff-puff, dough, bounce, eggroll, chin-chin, jollof-rice, fried rice, meat-pie and salad.

**Hair Styling** which includes weaving (Bob Marley), type of threading, fixing and Ghana weaving.

**Soap Making** which includes liquid soap, Izael, bleach and Air fresher.

All the training sections were fully practical.

In bid to fulfil her core mandate of ‘taking the children out of the street to the class where destinies are shaped’ the foundation registered (5) five pupils for 2019/2020 academic year at Saint Peter Primary School, Ilara-mokin, Ondo state, Nigeria. The beneficiary includes:

5. Emmanuel Oluwajomiloju - Nursery 2 (Male)


Also, the foundation presented scholarship award to the best school pupils in each class from primary 1 to 6 by paying for their school fee. The beneficiary includes:
